



## **Safety notes**



#### Danger to children!

Children can become trapped in the packing film when playing and suffocate.

- Do not allow children to play with the unit or the packing film. Danger of suffocation.
- Ensure that children do not remove small parts from the unit or take them off of the unit. They could swallow the parts and choke.



#### Caution!

Incorrect location may result in damage.

 Place the speakers in such a way that they cannot be knocked over unseen and make sure that the cables do not pose a trip hazard.

- Do not place the speakers near or directly above sources of heat (e.g. heaters, ovens, other heat generating equipment such as amplifiers etc.).
- Avoid direct sunlight at the setup location.



#### Warning of damage to property!

The isolation pads can produce discolouration on sensitive surfaces.

 On parquet, varnished wood and similar surfaces, you should stick felt gliders to the rubber feet of the speaker stand or put blankets or small carpets under them. This will prevent discolouration of the floor over the long term.







# Assembly of speaker stand for column speakers




1. Use two cylinder head screws (a) to screw the tube (1) securely onto the base plate (8). Align the tube so that the bolt (a) is facing forward.




3. Now run the speaker cable through the second tube ② from below until you can pull the speaker cable out of the upper opening.



2. Run the speaker cable through the hole in the base plate ⓐ and through the tube ① until it extends somewhat out of the tube on the top.




4. Push the tube ② all the way into the tube ①. Make sure that the large oval openings in the tube ② are facing to the



- 5. Connect the cable to the speaker.
- 6. Place the speaker with the bottom bracket on the bottom bolt (a).
- 7. Push the tube b up until the holding screw runs stops in the upper bracket.
- 8. Use the cylinder screw e to secure the tube.
- 9. Then tighten the countersunk head nut (**b**).

# Assembly of the speaker stand for micro-speakers




- 1. Screw the tube ② onto the base plate ⑧ with two cylinder header screws ⑥. Align the tube so that the bolt is facing forward.
- A B

2. Run the speaker cable either through the bottom hole in the base plate (example **A**) or through the lower opening in the tube (example **B**). Pull the cable through the tube until it extends out of the upper oval opening.

Depending on the design of your speakers, there are two options for fixing: A speakers with keyhole opening and B speakers with a threaded insert.


#### A Speakers with keyhole opening



- 1. Connect the speaker cable.
- 2. Carefully use the keyhole opening to hang the speaker on the pre-installed holding screw.

3. Tighten the countersunk head nut on the back.

#### **B** Speakers with threaded insert



- 1. First remove the pre-installed holding screw.
- 2. Turn the threaded pin into the threaded insert on the back of the speaker.
- Insert the threaded pin, which has been screwed into place, in the opening where the holding screw was installed before. Use the countersunk head nut on the back to screw it tight.
