The USB charger

The USB charger is designed so that you can also use it in the USA:



• For this purpose, push the plug adapter off upwards and fold the two contact pins out. The charger now also fits American sockets.

Once the rechargeable battery has been fully charged, pull the USB charger out of the socket and pull the USB plug out of the USB jack (10). You will save power this way.

To preserve the rechargeable battery, do not quickly connect and disconnect the charger and the ROCKSTER XS in succession.




