


1. What's in the box

Unpack the box carefully and ensure that the following parts are included. If any part is damaged or missing, do not use it and contact your retailer or customer service representative.



3. Getting started

3.1 Powering on & off

- Press and hold power button for
 seconds and the headphone will automatically turn on.
- Press and hold power button for 1.5 seconds and the headphone will automatically turn off.

3.2 Connecting the headphones

There are two types of ways to connect the headphone with your devices.

3.2.1 Gaming mode

You should first download Teufel Audio Center software from www. teufel.de and install it. Then insert the dongle and leave the headset powered off.

Press and hold the dongle button until the dongle LED flashes purple. Then press and hold the power button on the headphone for 8 seconds, until it also flashes purple. When the status LED lights up purple for 3 seconds, the pairing was

successful. After that you can control the headphone through Teufel Audio Center on your computer.



3.2.2 Bluetooth mode

To connect the headphone with your mobile devices, first push the slide switch to the Bluetooth mode. Turn on the headphone by pressing the power button for 1.5 sec and then press the power button twice to enter pairing mode. Enable the Bluetooth function on your electronic device and search for CAGE PRO to pair. When the headphone LED lights up solid blue for 3 seconds, the headphone was successfully paired.

3.3 Information on the **Bluetooth wireless** connection

The headphones are compatible with Bluetooth 5.2.

If you activate AAC on your audio source, the headphone automatically plays music in high quality.

The paired devices immediately establish the Bluetooth wireless connection after switching on and are ready for use.

When you switch the headphones on, they automatically try to connect to the last connected Bluetooth device.

3.4 Teufel Audio Center **Software**

The headset/dongle will interface with the Teufel Audio Center desktop application for Windows. The application will allow the user to configure various features of the headset.

If you like to tweak your sound, the software also provides a 10-band equalizer and multiple presets perfect for the most common contents.

5. Charging

5.1 Charging the headphone

Headphone begins charging when connected to a power source via USB-C cable.

Headphone stops charging when USB-C cable is disconnected.

5.1.1 Charging time

Charging via UBS-C, fully charged in 165 minutes:

Empty to 75% nominal capacity in 95 minutes:

NOTICE

Fully charged battery allows at least 12-hour use.

5.1.2 Check the headphone battery level

When using the headphones

If connected to an Apple or Android device, the device displays the approximate battery level in the Teufel Audio Center software and or in the notification bar.

When charging the headphones

When charging, Status LED glows according to charging status.

60% - 99% breathing green;

21% - 59% breathing yellow;

0% - 20%: Breathing red.

5.2 USB-C Charging

↑ CAUTION

Use this product only with an agency approved power supply which meets local regulatory requirements (e.g., CE. CCC).



- 1. Connect the small end of the supplied USB cable into the USB-C port.
- 2. Connect the other end into a USB wall charger (not provided).

NOTICE

Before charging, be sure that the headphones are at the correct operating temperature of between 0°C and 45°C.

6.2 Dongle LED Indications



Device state	Mode	Dongle LED
Microphone Muted	Gaming mode	Solid red (50% brightness)
Microphone Unmuted	Gaming mode	Solid white (50% brightness)
Dongle Power On	Gaming mode	While searching for headset: Breathing white for 30 seconds, then LED off (if still searching for connection)
Dongle Connected	Gaming mode	Solid white for 3 seconds, then dim down to 50% brightness
Dongle Disconnected	Gaming mode	Breathing white for 30 seconds, then LED off (if still searching for connection)
Dongle Pairing	Gaming mode	Fast Flashing purple
Dongle Pairing Successful	Gaming mode	Solid purple for 3 seconds, then fade out

7. Care and maintenance

7.1 Cleaning the headphone

The headphone may require periodic cleaning.

Ear cushions: Remove the ear cushions from the headphones and wash them with a mild detergent and water.

To avoid cracking or peeling of the ear cushions due to long term contact with bodily fluids e.g. sweat or oil, always clean them by wiping it with dry soft tools such as cotton swabs, balls, or pads.

Note: Make sure you thoroughly rinse and dry the ear cushions before re-attaching them to the headphones.

Charging port: To prevent rusting, regularly clean with a dry, soft cotton swab or equivalent.

7.2 Storing headphone

Headphone should be stored in a clean, dry area. If possible, the headphone may be hung up to minimize wear. If possible, always store your headphones in a case or protective bag when not in use. Do make sure the storage temperature range is between -20°C and 65°C. It is better to detach the boom arm for long-time no use.

8. Troubleshooting

If you experience problems with your headphones, see the table below to identify symptoms and solutions to common problems.

If you are still unable to resolve your issue, contact Teufel customer service.

Symptom	Solution
	1. Charge the headphone.
Headphones don't power on	Make sure the headphone is not in standby mode and wake it up by pressing the Power or Multifunction button.
Headphones don't connect with mobile device	Make sure your mobile device supports Bluetooth technology.
	2. On your mobile device: Turn the Bluetooth feature off and then on.
	3. Delete your Teufel CAGE PRO headphone from the Bluetooth list on your mobile device. Connect again.
	4. Move your mobile device closer to the headphones and away from any interference or obstructions.
	5. Connect a different mobile device.
	6. Clear the headphones pairing list and connect again. To clear Bluetooth device list, press and hold power button for 8 seconds in OFF state.
Headphones don't charge	Make sure that both ends of the USB cable are plugged in correctly and securely.
	2. If your headphone has been exposed to high or low temperatures, let it return to room temperature and then try charging again.

Symptom	Solution
No sound	Tap play on your mobile device to make sure the audio track is playing.
	2. Charge your headphone
	3. Increase the volume on the mobile device or on the computer.
	4. Move your mobile device closer to the headphones (10 m) and away from any interference or obstructions.
	5. Use a different music/game source.
	6. Connect a different mobile device.
Poor sound quality	Make sure that both headphones fit securely with your ear.
	2. Use a different music/game source.
	3. Try connecting another electronic device.
	4. Move your mobile device closer to the headphones (10 m) and away from any interference or obstructions when in Bluetooth mode.
	5. Clear any debris or wax buildup from the headphone and ear cushions.
No sound from one side	Make sure that the headphone is fully charged and that the headphone has successfully been paired with your electronic device and connected to it. Also make sure that you are wearing the headphone correctly.
Factory reset	To do this, press and hold the power button and multifunction button simultaneously for 4 seconds.

The power delivered by the charger must be between min 2.5 Watts required by the radio equipment, and max 5 Watts in order to achieve the maximum charging speed.

To charge the loudspeaker, we recommend the Lautsprecher Teufel Power Adapter 30 W USB-C E030-1P200150VE. With this power adapter, the power consumption in off mode is below the limit of 0.5 W required by the Ecodesign Directive.
